The R. C. Bose Centre for Cryptology and Security (RCBCCS) was established at the Indian Statistical Institute at Kolkata with the aim of promoting interdisciplinary research in Mathematics, Computer Science and Statistics towards furtherance of teaching, research as well as training and development in Cryptology and Cyber Security. The Indian Statistical Institute invites applications from Indian Nationals with an established record of high-quality research and development in the areas of Cryptology and Security for appointment to the post of the Head, RCBCCS. The appointment will be for a duration of five (5) years. The Head of RCBCCS will be placed in the pay level equivalent to that of a Professor in ISI. Salary at the level of Professor (HAG) may be considered based on the merit of the application. Other allowances will be as per the rules of the Institute. The candidate must be sixty (60) years or less as on December 31, 2020.

The selection will be made by the Competent Authority based on the recommendations of the Search cum Selection Committee. The Committee will consider applications received in response to this advertisement, as well as nominations received from eminent persons. The committee will also look for leadership qualities and a vision to take the Centre to a higher trajectory.
